




# One for... 21 ... that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. — Jesus — (John 17:21b) World

- <sup>4</sup> But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved <u>us</u>,
- $^5$  Even when  $\underline{we}$  were dead in sins, hath quickened  $\underline{us}$  together with Christ, (by grace  $\underline{ve}$  are saved;)
- $^6$  And hath raised  $\underline{us}$  up together, and made  $\underline{us}$  sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:
- $^7$  That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward  $\underline{us}$  through Christ Jesus.
- $^8$  For by grace are  $\underline{ve}$  saved through faith; and that not of  $\underline{yourselves}$ : it is the gift of God:
- <sup>9</sup> Not of works, lest any man should boast.



## **Modeling the Gospel**
